Queen of Peace Center gives women and their children who may not have a place to call home a safe, sober living environment that supports recovery and offers community. St. Philippine Maternity Home is a long-term residential program for pregnant and postpartum women and their children. Our Lady of Perpetual Help (OLPH) Recovery Housing provides permanent supportive housing for single women experiencing chronic homelessness and substance use disorders.

At this time, we are especially focused on making OLPH and St. Philippine child-oriented spaces, with activities for families to do together. Your donation will help mothers strengthen bonds with their children and build a sturdy foundation for the future.
